Highlights for the weekend include:

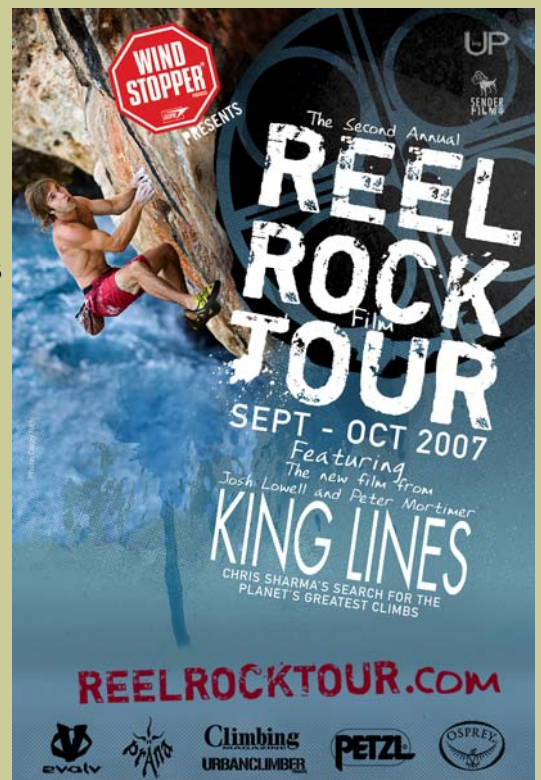
- Bouldering at the Stone Fort (formerly known as Little Rock City)
